

Kasiisi Project: Scholarship Program Student Report Legend

This legend will help you read your scholar's term report. On the student's report, find the section for Form. You will either see a number or a number and letter. The number stands for their class level.

- I = S1
- II = S2
- III = S3
- IV = S4

Next to the number you may or may not see a letter. The letter is their "stream" or section in school. A or X usually are for high performers, B/Y for average performers and C/Z are the rest. Once you have identified the student's class level, go to the appropriate section below to understand their grades.

S1 or S2

For S1 and S2, each subject is out of hundred. The aggregate average is the average of all subject scores. Therefore, the higher the score, the better the student is doing. This grading average perception is similar to the U.S.

S3 or S4

During S4, students take national exams. Ugandan schools use both S3 and S4 to prepare for those exams; therefore, the grading during S3 and S4 are the same.

To calculate the average, sum the Grade Number for the top 8 subjects. The lower the average, the better the student is doing. The best score is 8 and the worst is 72 for the grade. For the average, any around or above 70 is great and anything below 45/50 needs improvement.

National Guidelines:

Note: These numbers are national guidelines, but the ranges for the scores can be adjusted by the school depending on the exam difficulty. Math and English must be a pass.

A-Levels/S5 and S6 or Vocational School

After Secondary School (S1 to S4), the student may go to A-Levels to prepare for University or Vocational School to learn a skill.

A-Levels/S5 and S6 receive letter grades. Each grade is allocated a certain points. The higher the total points, the better the student is doing. The best score is 25; the sum of points for each grade plus a point for General Paper. (General Knowledge)

- D = 3
- F = 0
- B = 5
- E = 2
- O = 1
- C = 4
